By order dated 05/03/2026, this Board modified the earlier interim order dated 14/01/2026 and directed the Divisional Waqf Officer, Kozhikode to conduct an inspection through a competent officer and submit a detailed report regarding the condition of the compound wall and the necessity for reconstruction or repair, particularly considering the safety of the Madrassa students. Pursuant to the said order, the Divisional Waqf Officer, Kozhikode has submitted a detailed inspection report before this Board. On perusal of the report, it is seen that at present a compound wall having an approximate length of 120 meters is existing in the Waqf property and substantial portions of the said wall are found to be in a partially destroyed and damaged condition requiring immediate repair. It is further reported that for the remaining boundary portion having an approximate length of 130 meters, no compound wall presently exists and construction of a wall is necessary. The report further reveals that stray dogs are entering the Madrassa compound causing threat and insecurity to the children attending the Madrassa functioning in the Waqf property. The inspecting authority has specifically reported that construction and repair of the compound wall is essential for ensuring the safety and security of the children and other persons using the Waqf property. The matter was posted before this Board on 21/05/2026 for hearing and orders. The petitioner was heard. The learned counsel appearing for the respondents sought further time for filing argument notes and for advancing detailed submissions. However, having regard to the nature of the relief sought in the present Interlocutory Application and the urgency disclosed from the inspection report, this Board is of the view that the issue relating to the compound wall cannot be deferred. The inspection report clearly indicates that a Madrassa is presently functioning in the Waqf property and that the absence of a proper compound wall as well as the damaged condition of the existing wall pose safety and security concerns for the children attending the institution. The report also discloses that stray dogs are entering

the Madrassa premises, thereby creating a situation affecting the safety and well-being of the children. In such circumstances, this Board is satisfied that immediate orders are required in the interest of protecting the children and safeguarding the Waqf property. Accordingly, the request for further adjournment is declined to the limited extent necessary for considering the present interlocutory relief. It is made clear that the rights and contentions of all parties in the main Original Petition are left open for consideration at the appropriate stage.

This Board has carefully considered the inspection report and the materials available on record. The question regarding the continuance of the present committee is a matter pending consideration in the main Original Petition. However, the safety and protection of children attending the Madrassa cannot be ignored. The proposed work is limited to reconstruction and repair of the compound wall for ensuring safety and security and does not involve any other developmental activity or policy decision affecting the merits of the disputes raised in the Original Petition.

In the above circumstances, this Board is satisfied that permission can be granted for carrying out the necessary repair and reconstruction works strictly to the extent recommended in the inspection report and subject to the supervision of the Divisional Waqf Officer.

Accordingly, the Divisional Waqf Officer, Kozhikode is directed to accord necessary sanction/permission for the following works strictly in accordance with law and after complying with all procedural formalities:

1. Necessary repair and reconstruction works in the portions of the existing compound wall having an approximate length of 120 meters where the wall is found damaged or partially destroyed;
2. Construction of a new compound wall in the remaining boundary portion having an approximate length of 130 meters where no wall presently exists;
3. Installation of gate and connected safety measures, if found necessary by the Divisional Waqf Officer, for protection of the Madrassa students and for securing the Waqf property.

The Divisional Waqf Officer shall ensure that the construction is confined strictly to the purpose of safety and protection of the children and that no other construction activity is undertaken in the Waqf property under the guise of this permission.
