This Original Petition is filed seeking, inter alia, (i) to set aside the suspension orders dated 09.09.2023 issued against the petitioners as being illegal and violative of law, including the principles laid down in the decision reported in 2022 (1) <i>KHC 330</i>, (ii) to conduct an enquiry into the administration and management of the respondent Waqf, (iii) to issue directions to the respondent Jama-ath Committee to accept monthly subscription from the petitioners and to extend all services available to the members and beneficiaries of the Jama-ath, (iv) to appoint an Executive Officer for proper management of the Waqf, and (v) for other consequential reliefs.2. The case of the petitioners is that they are members and beneficiaries of the first respondent Jama-ath, which is a registered Waqf bearing Registration No. 3523/RA. It is contended that earlier the petitioners had approached this Board by filing OP No. 54/2022 challenging the election conducted on 07.01.2022. According to the petitioners, solely with an intention to wreak vengeance for having questioned the election and administration of the Jama-ath, the respondent committee initiated coercive and retaliatory steps against them, culminating in the impugned suspension dated 09.09.2023. It is alleged that the suspension was imposed without following the procedure contemplated under the bye-laws, without issuing a valid show cause notice, without affording an opportunity of explanation or hearing, and without serving the suspension order on the petitioners. It is further alleged that the suspension decision was publicly announced during Jumma prayers and published on the notice board, thereby causing humiliation and defamation.3. The petitioners further contended that denial of services by a mosque dedicated as Waqf affects their fundamental and statutory rights as beneficiaries, and that the Jama-ath

Committee, being a Mutawalli/management of a public religious Waqf, cannot treat the mosque or its services as its private property. It is asserted that suspension and denial of services for the sole reason of legally questioning the acts of the Jama-ath Committee is arbitrary, mala fide, and opposed to public policy and the very concept of Waqf.

4. The respondents entered appearance and filed counter statements. While admitting that the petitioners are beneficiaries of the first respondent Jama-ath, the respondents contended that the issues relating to election, constitution, management and administration of the Jama-ath are already the subject matter of OP No. 54/2022 and cannot be re-agitated in the present proceedings. The respondents denied the allegations of coercion and victimisation. With respect to the suspension, it is contended that the action was taken strictly in accordance with the bye-laws, that show cause notices were issued, and that the petitioners deliberately refused to receive the notices and failed to submit explanations. It is further contended that the suspension is only from membership and that there was no intention to deny religious or essential services to the petitioners.
5. The matter was heard in detail. During the course of hearing, the Jama-ath Committee conceded before the Board that they are prepared to extend all service benefits of the Jama-ath to the petitioners.
6. The issues that arise for consideration are whether the Jama-ath Committee is justified in denying services to the petitioners and whether disciplinary powers can be exercised in a manner that curtails the rights of beneficiaries for legally questioning the acts of the Jama-ath Committee.
7. It is well settled that a mosque dedicated as Waqf is a public religious endowment, and the Jama-ath Committee or Mutawalli is only a manager or trustee holding the Waqf property and administering its affairs for the benefit of the beneficiaries and the Muslim public at large. The management cannot arbitrarily deny services to beneficiaries. The power to impose discipline on members, if any, under the

bye-laws, is only to the extent necessary to maintain order and discipline in the Jama-ath and must always conform to the principles of natural justice, fairness, and reasonableness.

8. The Board is of the considered view that disciplinary powers cannot be exercised as a tool for victimisation or retaliation against members who lawfully question the acts, elections, or administration of the Jama-ath Committee before competent statutory forums. Any such action would have a chilling effect on the statutory right of beneficiaries to seek redressal and would be opposed to the very scheme of the Waqf Act.
9. Even assuming that the Jama-ath Committee has the authority to impose reasonable restrictions or disciplinary measures for maintaining discipline, such measures shall not extend to denying religious, social, or essential services of the mosque and the Jama-ath to its members and beneficiaries, nor to their family members. Denial of services on the ground that a member has approached this Board or any other lawful authority amounts to abuse of power and cannot be countenanced.
10. In view of the submissions made and the conceding recorded from the Jama-ath Committee, and having regard to the statutory nature of the Waqf and the rights of beneficiaries, this Board is of the firm opinion that the petitioners are entitled to receive all service benefits of the Jama-ath and the mosque, notwithstanding any internal disputes or disciplinary proceedings.

In the result, the Original Petition is disposed of with the following directions:

(i) The respondent Jama-ath Committee is directed to provide and ensure all services, facilities and benefits of the Jama-ath and the mosque to the petitioners and their family members as members and beneficiaries, without any discrimination.

(ii) While the Jama-ath Committee may impose reasonable restrictions on its members strictly for maintaining discipline in accordance with the bye-laws and law, such restrictions shall not,

	<p>under any circumstances, extend to denial of services or initiation of disciplinary action as a measure of vengeance or retaliation against persons who legally question the acts, elections, or administration of the Jama-ath Committee before competent authorities.</p> <p>(iv) Any future disciplinary action, if contemplated, shall strictly adhere to the principles of natural justice, including issuance of proper notice, opportunity to submit explanation, and affording a fair hearing, and shall be free from mala fides.</p> <p>(v) The respondent Jama-ath Committee is cautioned that any violation of the above directions will be viewed seriously and may invite appropriate action under the provisions of the UMEED Act and other applicable laws.</p>
